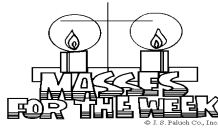
### Sacrament of Reconciliation/Confesiones:

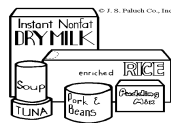

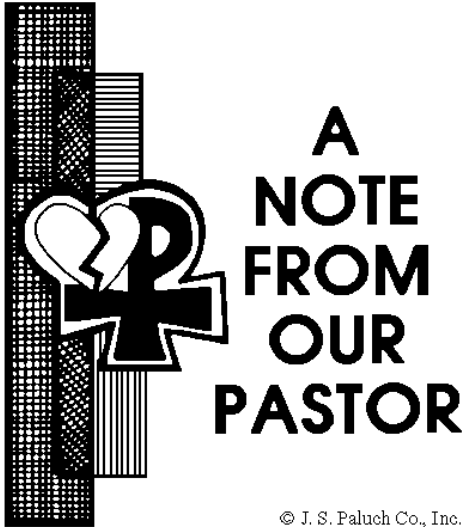
