FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI

SUNDAY, JUNE 18, 2017

We will celebrate our parish Feast Day with a special celebration of the Eucharist at 12:00 noon on Sunday, June 18. The 11:00 AM Spanish Mass and the 12:30 PM English Mass will be combined into a bi-lingual liturgy at 12:00 noon in the school gymnasium. Bishop James Massa will be the main celebrant at the Mass. After Mass there will be a procession with the Eucharist around the block stopping at 3 altars for Benediction prayers.

After the procession, there will be a celebration in the parking lot for all who attend. We are asking everyone to contribute to the celebration by bringing food and cakes. We are planning on just finger food, nothing that requires a fork to eat. There will be a sign up sheet in the back of the church if you would like to write what you plan to bring.

Please remember that there will not be an 11:00 AM or 12:30 PM Mass on June 18 and please plan to participate in this special Mass and procession as we honor the Lord in the Eucharist.
