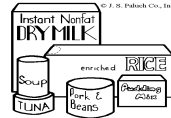

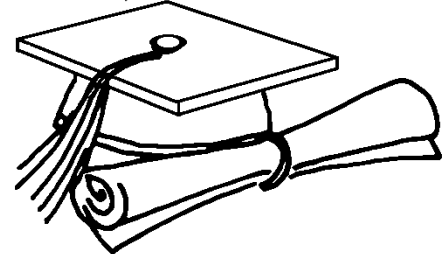

FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI

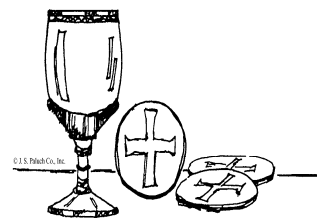
SUNDAY, June 18, 2017

We will celebrate our parish Feast Day with a special celebration of the Eucharist at 12:00 noon on Sunday, June 18. The 11:00 AM Spanish Mass and the 12:30 PM English Mass will be combined into a bi-lingual liturgy at 12:00 noon in the school gymnasium. Bishop James Massa will be the main celebrant at the Mass.

After Mass there will be a procession with the Eucharist around the block stopping at 3 altars for Benediction prayers.

After the procession, there will be a celebration in the parking lot for all who attend. We are asking everyone to contribute to the celebration by bringing food and cakes. ***We are planning on just finger food, nothing that requires a fork to eat.*** There will be a sign up sheet in the back of the church if you would like to write what you plan to bring.
