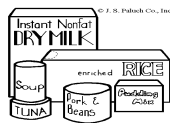

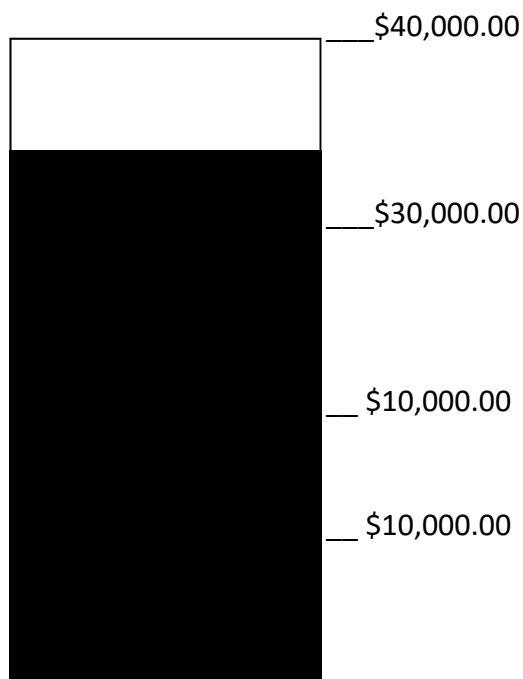

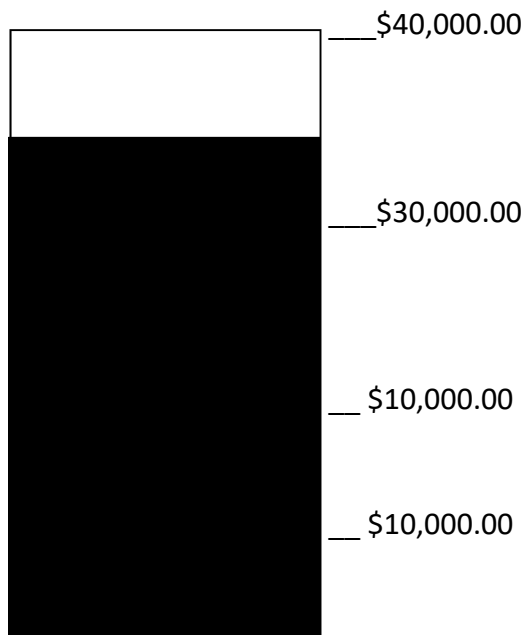
**ORACIÓN POR LAS VOCACIONES**
