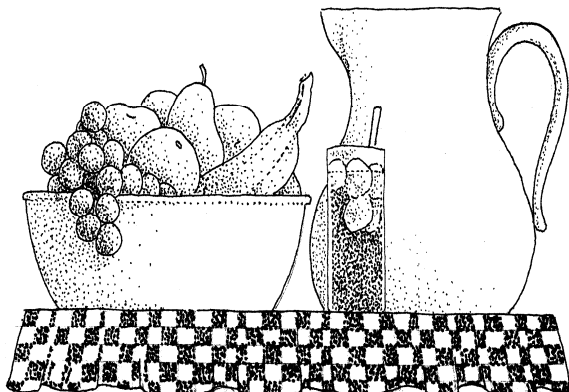

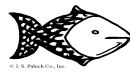

You may also want to check out BestLentEver.com. This is a catholic web site that offers a Lenten program that hopes to help you pray your way through Lent to help make it the best lent ever. As with FORMED, this service is offered free to all who would like to make this Lent a spiritual journey to help you grow in faith.

Stations of the Cross - Friday: 8:30 AM - English 7:00 p.m. - Spanish



The Stations of the Cross is an ancient devotion by which we walk with Jesus on His way to Calvary. We reflect on the unconditional love of the Lord for us and His willingness to take up His cross for us. 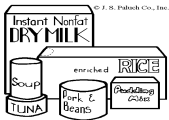
CALLING ALL TEENAGERS

ANNUAL VOTIVE CANDLES

Lighting candles is an honored tradition here at Corpus Christi and is really a much welcomed form of prayer. Votive or Vigil lights signify prayer to God or one of the Saints on behalf of someone, an intention, or our prayer for a deceased loved one, or ourselves. The candle keeps vigil, or watch, and continues day and night as a symbol of our ongoing prayer for the intention or the person.

Many people light a candle every week, but don't always get around to it for whatever reason. If that someone is you, you may wish to consider participating in the Corpus Christi Annual Votive Candle Program.

A donation of \$100 will ensure that a Votive Candle will burn daily in Corpus Christi Church for 52 week to memorialize your intention. Donations can be made at anytime during the year at the Rectory office.
