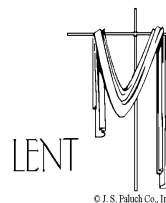

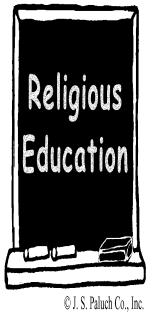
SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

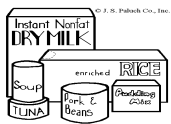

Are we people who follow the teachings of God, who obey the words of Christ in the second covenant in his blood? Or do we continue to wreak works of darkness and violence?
