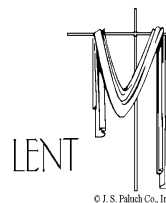

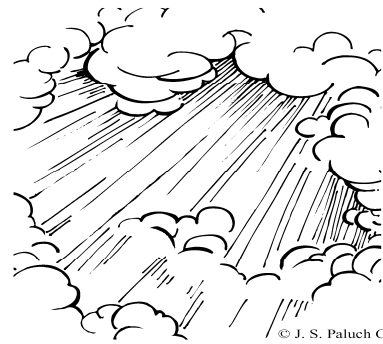

## **SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION**

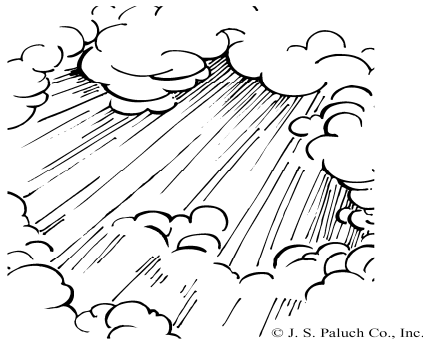
