Letter from the Administrator / Carta del Administrador

May God bless and protect the people of Corpus Christi Church!

We have two vocation stories in the readings today. In the first reading, we have the life and vocation story of Samuel. He was living with Eli in the Temple. One night, Samuel heard our Lord. He thought the voice was from Eli but the voice was from heaven. By the advice of the priest Eli, Samuel responded to the call: "Speak, for your servant is listening." We are given here the need and the power that there is in listening. The second vocation story in the gospel. This is about the calling of the first disciples of Jesus. Two of them were formerly disciples of John the Baptist who then followed Jesus.

To find our true vocation is very important to us. It is like finding the secret to happiness in life. Vocation, as Thomas Merton puts it, is the secret for which we are born.

God may be calling through the instrumentality of other person. So we have Eli for Samuel, John the Baptist for John and Andrew, and Andrew for Peter. Parents have a very important role in the vocation of their children. Saint Josemaría Escrivá de Balaguer, the Founder of Opus Dei, would say that 90% of the vocation of a person comes from the parents. Parents also should be attentive and discerning on the call of God to their children. They should help their children find their true vocation which would lead them to a happy life ahead.

In my personal vocation story, I did not hear the call of God at midnight. I did not hear the testimony of John the Baptist, etc. I had my parents helping me discern my vocation for which I am truly grateful.

Let us make our community of faith here in Corpus Christi a good place where one can discover his or her true vocation in life!

Los padres tienen un papel muy importante en la vocación de los hijos. San Josemaría Escrivá de Balaguer, Fundador del Opus Dei, diría que el 90% de la vocación de una persona proviene de los padres. Los padres también deben estar atentos y discernir el llamado de Dios a sus hijos. Deben ayudar a sus hijos a encontrar su verdadera vocación que los conducirá a una vida feliz por delante.

En la historia de mi vocación personal, no escuché el llamado de Dios a la medianoche. No escuché el testimonio de Juan el Bautista, etc. Tuve a mis padres ayudándome a discernir mi vocación por lo cual estoy verdaderamente agradecido.

St. Joseph Academy

LETTER OF APPEAL

January 8, 2021

Dear Parents, Alums, and Friends of the Academy,

As you may know, for the past fourteen years, St. Joseph Catholic Academy has partnered with the New York City Department of Education to enable us to offer families in our geographic area free pre-kindergarten services to their four-year-old children. During this time period, our contract with the department of education has been renewed and extended several times. During the past fourteen years, hundreds of youngsters and their families have benefitted from our program, and many chose to continue their elementary education at the Academy.

Our Pre-K for All Program, aka Universal Pre-Kindergarten, has been the recipient of numerous accolades over the years from the parents of the children enrolled with us, as well as from the results of rigorous reviews performed by objective, independent evaluation teams. Our program is well-known and popular among parents with young children in the Astoria/LIC communities and has grown in size over the years from the thirty-six children who began in 2007 to over eighty-five children each year in recent years. It is no surprise to us that we have begun to receive inquiries from parents who are interested in applying to us for September 2021 classes.

What did come as a surprise to us was receiving a letter in late July denying our request to renew our contract – beginning September 2021. Initially, we believed that the city must have made some mistake since it was clear to us that our program deserved the high praise it has received over the years – including from representatives of the city's division of early childhood. The only reason given by the department of education for denying the Academy a new contract is that "the need for services in this [geographic] area was met by proposals that received higher quality scores."

We then respectfully requested an appeal of the decision to deny the Academy a new contract. In response, we received a letter dated August 31 from a protest officer from the city who stated that he would "issue my recommendation for disposition as expeditiously as possible." Through our diocesan representatives, we have continued to be in contact with officers within the NYC department of education to appeal the decision, but our protestations remain unanswered to date.

Long-term, the Academy depends on the success of our early childhood programs, and as taxpaying residents of our city, our parents deserve to choose to receive these **free** pre-kindergarten services by attending the program of their choice. Since this is a matter of great urgency - having the potential for serious negative consequences to the Academy's viability - we are making an appeal to you to support our efforts to rescind the city's decision to deny the Academy a contract. Since registration for the pre-kindergarten program begins very soon, **please help us by visiting the Academy website at www.sjcalic.org/justice today and signing the on-line letter that will automatically be sent to the emails of several administrators within the department of education to express your outrage about this decision to deny the contract.** Please share the above link with anyone who may be willing to assist us. Also, we have engaged our diocesan attorneys to initiate litigation against the city unless our case is favorably resolved.
