Letter from the Administrator / Carta del Administrador

May God bless and protect the people of Corpus Christi Church!

The gospel today describes in very few words the end of Jesus' private life in Nazareth and, at same time, describes also the beginning of his public life when he was driven by the Holy Spirit out into the desert. In the desert, Jesus fasted and prayed for forty days and forty nights and then he was tempted by Satan.

This gospel is meaningful to us as we begin the observance of Lent because we are reliving in our own way those forty days and nights. There are three gospels which tells us about the temptation of Jesus: Matthew, Mark and Luke. These gospels are called synoptic which means that they describe the events in the life of Jesus in the same perspective. Matthew and Luke provides a lot more details during the temptation. Mark is very laconic in these few words: "The Spirit drove Jesus out into the desert, and he remained in the desert for forty days, tempted by Satan".

What is the message of Jesus to us why He let himself be subjected to temptations by Satan? Can Jesus be subjected to temptation being himself God? Let us not forget that Jesus is "true God and true Man". He is subjected to temptation not insofar as "God", but insofar as "Man" endowed with freedom.

Let us reflect on these mysteries of Lent.

¡Que Dios bendiga y proteja a los feligreses de la parroquia Corpus Christi!

El evangelio de hoy describe en muy pocas palabras el final de la vida privada de Jesús en Nazaret y, al mismo tiempo, describe también el comienzo de su vida pública cuando fue conducido por el Espíritu Santo al desierto. En el desierto, Jesús ayunó y oró durante cuarenta días y cuarenta noches y luego fue tentado por Satanás.

Este evangelio es significativo para nosotros al comenzar la observancia de la Cuaresma porque estamos reviviendo a nuestra manera esos cuarenta días y cuarenta noches. Hay tres evangelios que nos hablan de la tentación de Jesús: Mateo, Marcos y Lucas. Estos evangelios se llaman sinópticos, lo que significa que describen los eventos de la vida de Jesús en la misma perspectiva. Mateo y Lucas proporcionan muchos más detalles durante la tentación. Marcos es muy lacónico en estas pocas palabras: "El Espíritu echó a Jesús al desierto, y permaneció en el desierto durante cuarenta días, tentado por Satanás".

¿Cuál es el mensaje de Jesús para nosotros por qué se dejó someter a las tentaciones de Satanás? ¿Puede Jesús ser sometido a la tentación siendo él mismo Dios? No olvidemos que Jesús es "verdadero Dios y verdadero hombre". Él está sujeto a la tentación no en la medida en que "Dios", sino en la medida en que "Hombre" dotado de libertad.

Reflexionemos sobre estos misterios de Cuaresma.

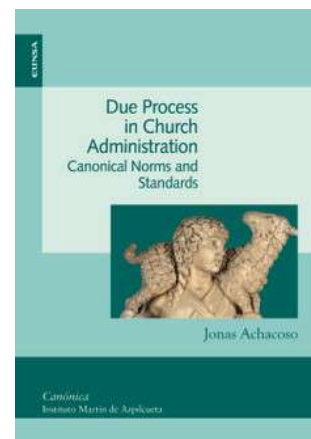

LETTER OF APPEAL

January 8, 2021

Dear Parents, Alums, and Friends of the Academy,

As you may know, for the past fourteen years, St. Joseph Catholic Academy has partnered with the New York City Department of Education to enable us to offer families in our geographic area free pre-kindergarten services to their four-year-old children. During this time period, our contract with the department of education has been renewed and extended several times. During the past fourteen years, hundreds of youngsters and their families have benefitted from our program, and many chose to continue their elementary education at the Academy.

Our Pre-K for All Program, aka Universal Pre-Kindergarten, has been the recipient of numerous accolades over the years from the parents of the children enrolled with us, as well as from the results of rigorous reviews performed by objective, independent evaluation teams. Our program is well-known and popular among parents with young children in the Astoria/LIC communities and has grown in size over the years from the thirty-six children who began in 2007 to over eighty-five children each year in recent years. It is no surprise to us that we have begun to receive inquiries from parents who are interested in applying to us for September 2021 classes.

What did come as a surprise to us was receiving a letter in late July denying our request to renew our contract – beginning September 2021. Initially, we believed that the city must have made some mistake since it was clear to us that our program deserved the high praise it has received over the years – including from representatives of the city's division of early childhood. The only reason given by the department of education for denying the Academy a new contract is that "the need for services in this [geographic] area was met by proposals that received higher quality scores."

We then respectfully requested an appeal of the decision to deny the Academy a new contract. In response, we received a letter dated August 31 from a protest officer from the city who stated that he would "issue my recommendation for disposition as expeditiously as possible." Through our diocesan representatives, we have continued to be in contact with officers within the NYC department of education to appeal the decision, but our protestations remain unanswered to date.

Long-term, the Academy depends on the success of our early childhood programs, and as taxpaying residents of our city, our parents deserve to choose to receive these **free** pre-kindergarten services by attending the program of their choice. Since this is a matter of great urgency - having the potential for serious negative consequences to the Academy's viability - we are making an appeal to you to support our efforts to rescind the city's decision to deny the Academy a contract. Since registration for the pre-kindergarten program begins very soon, **please help us by visiting the Academy website at www.sjcalic.org/justice today and signing the on-line letter that will automatically be sent to the emails of several administrators within the department of education to express your outrage about this decision to deny the contract.** Please share the above link with anyone who may be willing to assist us. Also, we have engaged our diocesan attorneys to initiate litigation against the city unless our case is favorably resolved.

Parochial Announcements / Anuncios Parroquiales

LENTEN REGULATIONS

1. Abstinence: All the faithful who have reached 14 years of age are required to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.

2. Fasting: All the faithful between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday. Fasting means limiting oneself to one full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may be taken on two other occasions during the day.

3. Easter Duty: After being fully initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, all the faithful are bound to receive Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept must be fulfilled in the Easter Season unless, for a good reason, it is fulfilled at another time. By special permission, in the USA, the period for fulfilling this precept is extended to include the period from the 1st Sunday of Lent (February 21 until Pentecost (May 23). It should be noted that the dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass is still in effect; therefore, the obligation to receive Holy Communion reasonably can be transferred to another time this year.

LEGION OF MARY. The weekly meeting of the Legion of Mary is held every Saturday, at 2:00pm in St Therese Room of Corpus Christi Parish Center in 60th Street. Mask is obligatory for those attending in person. Sanitizers will be provided.

There is an option to attend the meeting online through zoom. The meeting is from the three praesidia: Our Lady of Fatima Praesidium (Our Lady of Fatima Church), Hail Mary Full of Grace Praesidium (Corpus Christi Church) and Queen of the Apostles Praesidium (St Bartholomew Church).

ANOTHER WAY TO STAY INFORMED. The situation we are facing changes by the day. We want to communicate with you to keep you informed about schedule changes. There is a service you can get on your cell phone called REMIND. You can sign up by texting @f4ce7f to this number - 81010. As things develop we will send out notifications that will go directly to you.

REGLAMENTOS DE CUARESMA

1. Abstinencia: Todos los fieles que hayan cumplido los 14 años deben abstenerse de comer carne el Miércoles de Ceniza y todos los viernes de Cuaresma.

2. Ayuno: Todos los fieles de entre 18 y 59 años inclusive están obligados a ayunar el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo. Ayunar significa limitarse a una comida completa y evitar comer entre comidas. Se puede tomar un sustento ligero en otras dos ocasiones durante el día.

3. Deber Pascual: Después de ser plenamente iniciados en la Santísima Eucaristía, todos los fieles están obligados a recibir la Sagrada Comunión al menos una vez al año. Este precepto debe cumplirse en el tiempo pascual a menos que, por una buena razón, se cumpla en otro momento. Con un permiso especial, en los Estados Unidos, el período para el cumplimiento de este precepto se amplía para incluir el período desde el primer domingo de Cuaresma (21 de febrero hasta Pentecostés 23 de mayo). Se debe considerar que esta todavía en vigor la dispensa para asistir en la misa dominical. Por eso, transferir a otro momento la recepción de la Sagrada Comunión se puede hacer razonablemente.

LEGION DE MARIA. El Presidio del Inmaculado Corazón de María se reúne los sábados a las 4pm en el sótano del Centro parroquial. Los primeros sábados rezan el Rosario para los no nacidos. Los segundos sábados para la santidad de los sacerdotes. El director espiritual es el Dco. Juan Zhagñay.

OTRA MANERA DE ESTAR INFORMADO. La situación a la que nos enfrentamos cambia día a día. Queremos comunicarnos con usted para mantenerlo informado sobre los cambios de horario.
