Letter from the Administrator / Carta del Administrador

May God bless and protect the people of Corpus Christi Church!

The mystery of the Assumption of Our Lady has had a long history and has been celebrated by the Catholic Church. It was only in 1950 that the mystery is declared a dogma of faith. Pope Pius XII declared the dogma of the Assumption of Our Lady in the following words: "we pronounce, declare, and define it to be a divinely revealed dogma: that the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory" (*Munificentissimus Deus*, n. 44). The Holy Father continued to say that all Catholics should hold this truth and thus we believe that: Mary is in heaven both body and soul; that she did not experience the corruption of the body: that the assumption was a singular prerogative she enjoys; and that she is the image of the future church.

Mary is assumed to heaven because God wants to give Her the honor. We should join God in His love to the Blessed Mother. Our devotion to our Lady is in fact a praise to the workings of God Almighty in Her. So the praises we give to our Lady are in reality praises to God the Almighty. Like God, we should never cease to love Her.

*El misterio de la Asunción de Nuestra Señora tiene una larga historia y ha sido celebrado por la Iglesia Católica. Fue solo en 1950 que este misterio se declaró como un dogma de fe. El Papa Pío XII declaró el dogma de la Asunción de Nuestra Señora con las siguientes palabras: "Lo pronunciamos, declaramos y definimos como un dogma divinamente revelado: que la Inmaculada Madre de Dios, la siempre Virgen María, habiendo completado el curso de su vida terrena, fue asumida en cuerpo y alma en la gloria celestial" (*Munificentissimus Deus*, n. 44). El Santo Padre continuó diciendo que todos los católicos deben sostener esta verdad y por eso creemos que: María está en el cielo tanto en cuerpo como en alma; que no experimentó la corrupción del cuerpo: que la ascensión es una prerogativa singular que ella disfruta; y que ella es la imagen de la futura iglesia.*

María asciende al cielo porque Dios quiere darle el honor. Debemos unirnos a Dios en su amor por la Santísima Madre. Nuestra devoción a Nuestra Señora es de hecho una alabanza a las obras de Dios Todopoderoso en Ella. Entonces, las alabanzas que damos a nuestra Señora son en realidad alabanzas a Dios Todopoderoso. Como Dios, nunca debemos dejar de amarla.

Dear Parishioners,

I am writing to you in mid-summer with wishes that you will be able to take time for some rest and relaxation for yourself and your family before school resumes in the fall. If you do not have school-aged children, consider this message an opportunity to keep informed about "Good News" from the Academy. Regardless, we at the Academy ask for your prayers and support as we are about to embark on another new beginning in September. It is one of the perks of being in education that one can always look forward to new beginning at the start of every new school year.

As you may know, Bishop DiMarzio has aligned six parishes to St. Joseph Catholic Academy – St. Joseph, Corpus Christi, Most Precious Blood, St. Rita, St. Patrick, and Our Lady of Mt. Carmel. This is done to help ensure that the pastoral needs of the children are met by the pastors and associates who celebrate liturgies and visit classrooms throughout the year. It is also a promise to the faithful in all six parishes that Catholic education is alive and well in the Astoria/LIC/Woodside neighborhoods. St. Joseph Catholic Academy extends an invitation to the families in all six parishes to consider giving your children the gift of a Catholic education.

In June, we graduated thirty-eight eighth graders representing all but one of the six aligned parishes. This is a testament to the viability and accessibility of the Academy – serving generations of families since the Sisters of St. Dominic – Amityville Congregation - came to the parish in 1880. Accessibility: many of our children receive free DOT yellow bus service, and viability: financial assistance is available to qualifying families.

We have much for which to be grateful as we begin again in September – most especially the generosity of our families and alums that have supported our Air-Conditioning Campaign which will allow us to reopen school with fully air-conditioned classrooms for the first time in our hundred+ year history. Another historical first – due to financial support as well as grants that we have received – is that we will be opening with one-to-one electronic resources for our student population. I will have much more to share about the Academy in future monthly messages in the parish bulletin.

In the meantime, enjoy the remaining weeks of school's recess and consider enrolling your child with us for the fall semester. You can learn more about the Academy and registration information at www.sjcalic.org.
