Letter from the Pastor / Carta del Pastor

May God bless and protect the people of Corpus Christi Church!

The readings today highlight the reality of the suffering Messiah. To save mankind, Jesus has to suffer and die. In the first reading, the prophet Isaiah foretells the suffering of Jesus through the figure of the suffering servant. "I gave my back to those who beat me, my cheeks to those who plucked my beard; my face I did not shield from buffets and spitting". In the gospel, Peter had the correct response to Jesus' question "Who do you say that I am". But Peter missed the point when he rebuked Jesus not wanting him to suffer. Peter was as if saying: You are the Messiah. You should enjoy your dignity and highness. You should not suffer, much less die. But Jesus reprimanded Peter: "Get behind me, Satan. You are thinking not as God does, but as human beings do."

Never had Jesus rebuked anyone as Satan. He did this only once and such was addressed to Peter. Let us reflect on this incident so as to be warned and not fall into where Peter had fallen. Who is Satan? Satan is the enemy of Christ or anti-Christ. Satan wants to impede Jesus to carry out his mission, the salvation of souls.

Las lecturas de hoy resaltan la realidad del sufrimiento del Mesías. Para salvar a la humanidad, Jesús tiene que sufrir y morir. En la primera lectura, el profeta Isaías predice el sufrimiento de Jesús por la figura del siervo sufriente. "Ofrecí la espalda a los que me golpeaban, la mejilla a los que me tiraban de la barba. No aparté mi rostro de los insultos y salivazos". En el evangelio, Pedro tuvo la respuesta correcta a la pregunta de Jesús "¿Quién dicen que soy yo?" Pero Pedro malentendió el punto cuando reprendió a Jesús porque no quería que sufriera. Pedro estaba como diciendo: Tú eres el Mesías. Deberías disfrutar de tu dignidad y alteza. No debes sufrir y mucho menos morir. Pero Jesús reprendió a Pedro: "Apártate de mí, Satanás. Porque tú no juzgas según Dios, sino según los hombres".

Jesús nunca había reprendido a nadie como Satanás. Hizo esto solo una vez y se dirigió a Pedro. Reflexionemos sobre este incidente para ser advertidos y no caer en donde había caído Pedro. ¿Quién es Satanás? Satanás es el enemigo de Cristo o el anticristo. Satanás quiere impedir que Jesús lleve a cabo su misión, la salvación de las almas.

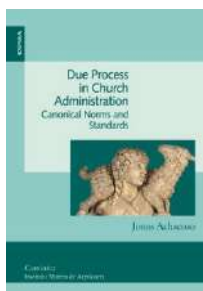

Dear Parishioners,

I am writing to you in mid-summer with wishes that you will be able to take time for some rest and relaxation for yourself and your family before school resumes in the fall. If you do not have school-aged children, consider this message an opportunity to keep informed about "Good News" from the Academy. Regardless, we at the Academy ask for your prayers and support as we are about to embark on another new beginning in September. It is one of the perks of being in education that one can always look forward to new beginning at the start of every new school year.

As you may know, Bishop DiMarzio has aligned six parishes to St. Joseph Catholic Academy – St. Joseph, Corpus Christi, Most Precious Blood, St. Rita, St. Patrick, and Our Lady of Mt. Carmel. This is done to help ensure that the pastoral needs of the children are met by the pastors and associates who celebrate liturgies and visit classrooms throughout the year. It is also a promise to the faithful in all six parishes that Catholic education is alive and well in the Astoria/LIC/Woodside neighborhoods. St. Joseph Catholic Academy extends an invitation to the families in all six parishes to consider giving your children the gift of a Catholic education.

In June, we graduated thirty-eight eighth graders representing all but one of the six aligned parishes. This is a testament to the viability and accessibility of the Academy – serving generations of families since the Sisters of St. Dominic – Amityville Congregation - came to the parish in 1880. Accessibility: many of our children receive free DOT yellow bus service, and viability: financial assistance is available to qualifying families.

We have much for which to be grateful as we begin again in September – most especially the generosity of our families and alumni that have supported our Air-Conditioning Campaign which will allow us to reopen school with fully air-conditioned classrooms for the first time in our hundred+ year history. Another historical first – due to financial support as well as grants that we have received – is that we will be opening with one-to-one electronic resources for our student population. I will have much more to share about the Academy in future monthly messages in the parish bulletin.

In the meantime, enjoy the remaining weeks of school's recess and consider enrolling your child with us for the fall semester. You can learn more about the Academy and registration information at www.sjcalic.org.
