Letter from the Pastor / Carta del Pastor

In the first reading, Moses presented the commandments to the Israelites. They call this the Shema, which in Hebrew means "Hear, O Israel: the Lord is our God, the Lord alone". This prayer is very important to the Hebrews. In the evening, it is the last words that parents would whisper to the ears of their children as a prayer and religious instruction. Jesus might have known the prayer from Mary and Joseph.

In the gospel, Jesus gives us the two greatest commandments in the manner that Moses gave the 10 commandments. "The first is this: Hear, O Israel! The Lord our God is Lord alone! You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength. The second is this: You shall love your neighbor as yourself".

That is why we should be very conscientious and prioritize above all else the fulfilment of our duties to God and to his Church with our whole heart, soul, mind and strength. We should also hold as very important our duties to our neighbor. We have to give ourselves: listening, understanding, loving...

¡Que Dios bendiga y proteja a la gente de la Iglesia de Corpus Christi!







I am pleased to be in contact again with more “good news” from our Academy at St. Joseph. We have just completed six full weeks of in-person learning and happily have experienced no interruptions due to the Covid pandemic. The students and teachers are grateful to be back in the building every day.

Our Catholic identity continues to be strong as we begin to implement the new diocesan social justice curriculum and await the celebration of All Saints Day with a special afternoon liturgy celebrated by St. Joseph pastor, Father Chirichella. In keeping with our mission to teach children about the importance of helping those less fortunate, we are reviving the tradition of a Thanksgiving Food Drive to assist needy families in the area.

Fulfilling our mission to teach the whole child, we brought back several of our co-curricular programs including

STEM lab, filmmaking, dance, and yoga. Our world languages program includes Spanish and Mandarin Chinese, and we will soon revive afterschool Italian class and the altar servers program with the help of Father Alessandro Linardi – the parochial vicar here at the parish.

Unfortunately, the Covid protocols associated with this pandemic continue to prevent us from renewing all of our traditions – including our once-vibrant monthly field trip program and most of all - the nearly fifty-year tradition of our Christmas play – a special yearly event shared by generations within families that have attended St. Joseph. Nonetheless, we remain grateful and hopeful as school life continues to improve.

All in all, we are off to a great start, and we continue to ask you to keep our Academy community in your thoughts and prayers.




