Letter from the Pastor / Carta del Pastor

May God bless and protect the people of Corpus Christi Church!

The first reading gives us the story of the creation of man and woman. There were already many animals as companions of man, but he was incomplete. God sees that the suitable partner for man is a woman. Hence, woman completes man, and man completes woman.

The gospel confirms this reality: "For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh... what God has joined together, no human being must separate".

Jesus elevates the natural institution of marriage into the sacrament of matrimony. The ideal marriage is a lifetime commitment. Divorce, in this way, challenges the permanence of marriage in time. Moses allowed divorce for reasons which the gospel says as "stubbornness of heart". Moses wanted to protect women because, if they separate from their husband, they can be accused of abandonment and be vulnerable to the punishment of death by stoning.

With the possibility of divorce around, marriage becomes permanent "until further notice" which is not what God intended marriage and family to be.

La primera lectura nos da la historia de la creación del hombre y la mujer. Ya había muchos animales como compañeros del hombre, pero Dios ve que la pareja adecuada para el hombre es una mujer. Por tanto, la mujer completa al hombre y el hombre completa a la mujer.

El evangelio confirma esta realidad: "Por eso dejará el hombre a su padre y a su madre y se unirá a su esposa y serán los dos una sola cosa. De modo que ya no son dos, sino una sola cosa... lo que Dios unió, que no lo separe el hombre".

Jesús eleva la institución natural del matrimonio al nivel sacramental. El matrimonio ideal es un compromiso de por vida. El divorcio, de esta manera, desafía la permanencia del matrimonio en el tiempo. Moisés permitió el divorcio por razones que el evangelio dice como "la dureza del corazón". Moisés quería proteger a las mujeres porque, si se separan de su esposo, pueden ser acusadas de abandono y ser vulnerables al castigo de muerte por lapidación. La mujer divorciada tendrá ahora un decreto de legalidad de su separación.

Con la posibilidad de divorcio, el matrimonio se vuelve permanente "hasta nuevo aviso", que no es lo que Dios quiere que fueran el matrimonio y la familia.



Dear Parishioners,

I am happy to contact you again with more "good news" from our Academy at St. Joseph. Last time you heard from me in mid-August, we were busy preparing to reopen the Academy for the 2021-2022 school year. As I write today, Friday, September 17, we are ending our first full week of classes – and what an exciting and successful week it has been.

Our early childhood enrollment of three and four year olds is at capacity. While social distancing protocols due to Covid have restricted the number of new registrations in kindergarten through eighth grade, we have limited availability on some grade levels. It may still be possible for you to give your child the gift of a Catholic education with us at St. Joseph this year.

On Wednesday, September 15, our students and teachers gathered in church where Father Vincent, pastor at St. Joseph, Father Vedran, pastor of Most Precious Blood, and Father Cassar, a retired priest residing at St. Joseph, concelebrated a beautiful liturgy to mark the spiritual beginning of our school

year. Our co-curricular programs in art, music, physical education, S.T.E.M, Mandarin, and Spanish have begun, and beginning next week, we will be adding yoga, dance, and drama to enable us to fulfill our mission to educate the whole child.

While the country is still feeling the effects of the pandemic, we are managing to provide in-person instruction and following all health and safety protocols established through the Department of Health and Centers for Disease Control. Our team of counselors has established a program to help the children readjust socially and emotionally after a long stretch of being away physically from their peers and adults in school. Our dedicated and experienced faculty have begun to address the learning gaps that could have resulted from the past two school years of interrupted and remote learning.

All in all, we are off to a great start, and we continue to ask you to keep our Academy community in your thoughts and prayers.
